

## Foreword

Safe operation of the fork lift truck requires specific knowledge which is imparted by the presentation of operating instructions. The information is presented in concise and clearly laid-out form. Individual chapters are arranged in alphabetical order and every chapter starts with page 1. The individual pages are identified by the chapter letter and the page number.

Example: Page B2 is the second page of chapter B.

Various truck variants are described in these operating instructions. During operation and maintenance work, pay attention that the description appropriate to the truck type is used.

Safety instructions and important notes are defined by the following pictograms:

 Used before safety instructions that have to be observed in order to prevent danger to personnel.

 Used before notes that have to be observed in order to prevent damage to equipment.

 Used before general notes and explanations.

- Used to indicate standard equipment.
- Used to indicate optional equipment.
