

Service Manual





This service manual is intended to be an aid for the disassembly and reassembly of your TENNANT Model 7100.

The set is organized into Four major groups: General Information, Chassis, Scrubbing, and Electrical.

General Information: Safety precautions, machine transport, machine jacking, machine storage, chassis lubrication, machine specifications, and machine maintenance chart.

Chassis: Tire/wheel replacement, brake adjustment and replacement, steering adjustment and replacement, and machine cab information.

Scrubbing: Scrub head repair/replacement, brush repair/replacement, skirt/seal repair/replacement, squeegee repair/replacement, solution and recovery tank ep ir/replacement, and scrubbing troubleshooting.

Electrical: Battery maintenance and replacement, examples of the schematics, and electrical troubleshooting.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The following symbols are used throughout this manual as indicated in their description:



WARNING: To warn of hazards or unsafe practices that could result in severe personal injury or death.

FOR SAFETY: To identify actions that must be followed for safe operation of equipment.

This machine is designed solely for scrubbing dirt and dust in an indoor environment. Tennant does not recommend using this machine in any other environment.

The following information signals potentially dangerous conditions to the operator or equipment. Read this manual carefully. Know when these conditions can exist. Locate all safety devices on the machine. Then, take necessary steps to train machine operating personnel. Report machine damage or faulty operation immediately. Do not use the machine if it is not in proper operating condition.

FOR SAFETY:

- 1. Do not operate macine
 - Unless trained and a thorized.
 - Unless operation , mual is read and understood.
 - In flamme' 'e c xplosive areas unless designe for 'se in those areas.
- 2. Before 'ar ng machine:
 - I ak sure all safety devices are in and operate properly.
 - Chark brakes and steering for proper peration (if so equipped).
- 3. When using machine:
 - Go slow on inclines and slippery surfaces.
 - Use care when backing machine.
 - Follow mixing and handling instructions on chemical containers.
- 4. Before leaving or servicing machine:
 - Stop on level surface.
 - Set parking brake (if equipped).
 - Turn off machine and remove key.

- 5. When servicing machine:
 - Avoid moving parts. Do not wear loose jackets, shirts, or sleeves when working on machine.
 - Block machine tires before jacking machine up.
 - Jack machine up at designated locations only. Block machine up with jack stands.
 - Use hoist or jack that will support the weight of the machine.
 - Wear eye and ear protection when using pressurized air or water.
 - Disconnect battery connections before working on machine.
 - Avoid contact with battery acid.
 Use Tennant supplied or equivalent placement parts.
- When loading/unloading machine onto/off truck or trailer:
 - Turn off machine.
 - Use truck or trailer that will support the weight of the machine.
 - Use winch. Do not drive the machine onto/off the truck or trailer unless the load height is 380 mm (15 in) or less from the ground.
 - Set parking brake after machine is loaded.
 - Block machine tires.
 - Tie machine down to truck or trailer.



WARNING: Batteries emit hydrogen gas. Explosion or fire can result. Keep sparks and open flame away. Keep covers open when charging.



WARNING: Flammable materials can cause an explosion or fire. Do not use flammable materials in tank(s).



WARNING: Flammable materials or reactive metals can cause explosion or fire. Do not pick up.
