

This service manual is intended to be an aid for the disassembly and reassembly of your TENNANT Model 7400.

This manual is organized into seven major groups: General Information, Chassis, Scrubbing, Electrical, Hydraulics, Engine-G/LPG and Engine-D.

General Information: Machine transport, machine jacking, machine storage, machine specifications, and machine maintenance chart.

Chassis: Tire/wheel replacement, brake adjustment and replacement, chassis lubrication, steering adjustment and replacement.

Scrubbing: Scrubber head repair/replacement, brush repair, polacement, squeegee repair/replacement, and scrubber troubling shooting.

Electrical: Battery maintenance and replacement, inclument panel replacement, and electrical troubleshooting.

Hydraulics: Valve replacement/repair, muto epiacement/repair, cylinder replacement/repair, pump replacement/repair, filter replacement and bouraulics troubleshooting.

Engine - G/LPG: Air filter replace, of changing, cooling system maintenance/repair, fuel system maintenance/repair, govern r a just nent/repair, engine repair, engine troubleshooting, and engine repairs.

Engine - D: Air filter place nent, oil changing, cooling system maintenance/repair, fuel system maintenance/repair not nor adjustment/repair, engine repair, engine troubleshooting, and engine repairs.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The following precautions are used throughout this manual as indicated in their description:



WARNING: To warn of hazards or unsafe practices which could result in severe personal injury or death.

FOR SAFETY: To identify actions which must be followed for safe operation of equipment.

The machine is suited to sweep disposable debris. Do not use the machine other than described in this Operator Manual. The machine is not designed for use on public roads.

The following information signals potentially dangerous conditions to the operator or equipment:

FOR SAFETY:

- 1. Do not operate machine:
 - Unless trained and authorized.
 - Unless operator manual is real understood.
 - If it is not in proper operation.
 - In flammable or e. lo ive areas unless designed for use in lose areas.
 - In areas with performing objects unless equipmed "th overhead guard.
- 2. Before star.ir g pachine:
 - Chect. or Jal, oil, and liquid leaks.
 - Keep so; ks and open flame away for rerueling area.
 - sure all safety devices are in rlass and operate properly. check brakes and steering for proper operation.
- 3. When starting machine:
 - Keep foot on brake and directional pedal in neutral.
- 4. When using machine:
 - Use brakes to stop machine.
 - Go slow on inclines and slippery surfaces.
 - Use care when reversing machine.
 - Do not carry passengers on machine.
 - Always follow safety and traffic rules.
 - Report machine damage or faulty operation immediately.

- 5. Before leaving or servicing machine:
 - Stop on level surface.
 - Set parking brake.
 - Turn off machine and remove key.
- 6. When servicing machine:
 - Avoid moving parts. Do not wear loose jackets, shirts, or sleeves.
 - Block machine tires before jacking machine up.
 - Jack machine up at designated locations only. Block machine up with jack stands.
 - Use hoist or jack of adequate capacity to lift machine.
 - Wear eye and ear protection when using pressurized air or water.
 - isconnect battery connections before working on machine.
 - Avoid contact with battery acid.
 - Avoid contact with hot engine coolant.
 - Allow engine to cool.
 - Keep flames and sparks away from fuel system service area. Keep area well ventilated.
 - Use cardboard to locate leaking hydraulic fluid under pressure.
 - Use Tennant supplied or approved replacement parts.



WARNING: Engine emits toxic gases. Severe respiratory damage or asphyxiation can result. Provide adequate ventilation. Consult with your regulatory authorities for exposure limits. Keep engine properly tuned.
